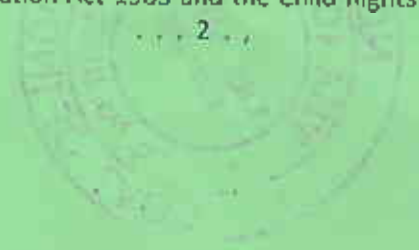
Subject: Regarding grant of school recognition as per rules framed under Child Rights Education Act-2009 and Karnataka Education Act-1983.

Officials of the Department verified the documents and spot inspection was done, accordingly renewal of recognition has been renewed subject to the following conditions.

Conditions

1. In accordance with the Child Rights Education Act-2009, and the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the rules made thereunder. The school is registered and the accreditation is renewed up to the class of the registered school (Elementary Education / Secondary Education) 1 to 5th [1 to 5, 1 to 8, 6 to 8, 9 and 10 and 1 to 10] No additional classes and sections are allowed to be conducted apart from above mentioned classes of this schools. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the Child Rights Education Act-2009.



3. Child Rights to Education Act-2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed for schools covered under RTE . The Government shall be authorized to register reserved seats under RTE. (Government has formulated rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government and government-funded educational institution), children will be enrolled in that school; otherwise, private schools will enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. To enable these children to continue their education without any discrimination.
4. As explained in Annexure 3, the fees of the children enrolled under RTE rules are released by the Government as per the rules and hence the collection of any fees from these children is prohibited.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the patrons either at the time of enrollment or thereafter.
6. As per State Government Order No: ED: 31: PJC 2019 Dated : 27/07/2019 Information on Fees collected by the School / Governing Body as tuition fee from parents of children has to be published on departmental website and school notice board. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The School/Managing Board shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
8. The school/governing body cannot refuse enrollment against the following points.
 - (i) Due to lack of age proof
 - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language
 - (iii) If admission is sought after the extended period of admission
9. Carrying out all safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules (Fire Safety and Building Safety Certificate from concerned authorities and Child Learning Safety as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R).
10. The School / Governing Body is as follows
 - (i) No admitted child shall be held back in any class until completion of primary education and secondary education in the school or by the school.
 - (ii) No child should be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule-21 and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules, the school also caters for children with special needs/specially challenged children also should be included.
 - (vi) Appointed teachers shall possess the minimum qualifications as prescribed for primary and high school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.
 - (vii) Salary and allowances payable to teachers and terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And salaries are paid to teachers through government notification (Provident Fund) and payable bank and other salaries will be paid to the teachers, and should be covered under Employee State Insurance (ESI).
 - (viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section-24(1) of the Act and RTE Act and Rules and Rule-17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.
11. To follow the syllabus and text books of the educational authority with which the school is affiliated.
12. The school shall enroll students as per the facilities available in the school as specified in Section-19 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
The school shall maintain the rules and standards as specified in Section-19 of the Department as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.



14. Class / Sections (Branch) should not be opened unauthorized in or outside the school premises.
15. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or politics during the day or night.
16. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
17. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and submit a copy to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
18. The School shall follow the Language Policy as per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy-2016].
19. Governing body and teachers to act as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
20. The School / Governing Body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department without fail.
21. Mandatory and regular updating of school information in SATS by the end of March every year.
22. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
